

### **KESHAV SITA MEMORIAL FOUNDATION TRUST**

It is a registered charitable trust (E3989/2003) that has been working on various projects. For more than Five years, the trust has been involved in creating awareness of segregation at source as well as collection of waste plastic from various areas in Pune city and its surrounding areas. For any waste management to succeed its utmost importance to create the awareness and system of segregation at source. At present collection happens along with Pune city, PCMC, Thane, Dombiwali, Baramati, Mahad, Dehu and surrounding forts (Sinhgad, Sajjangad).

#### At present, the collection happens from almost 25,000 households, hotels and businesses.

Keshav Sita trust has been connecting with many societies by creating awareness of segregation at source by personally conducting meetings with flat holders and society committee as well as various hotels/offices. This personal contact has helped the trust create awareness but the willing army of people who have started segregation and giving the plastic to trust as well as spreading the word in their respective areas.

Keshav Sita Trust is creating circular economy. It is part of Made in India mission, Swatch Bharat, Women Empowerment and Environment.

Until date, we have collected more than 10,00,000 KG of waste plastic, i.e. reduction of 60,00,000 kg of carbon dioxide emission.



COVID 19 PANDEMIC

During these difficult times, when many facing various challenges, we at Keshav Sita memorial foundation trust have undertaken various activity.

#### 1. Vegetable / Fruits at reasonable rate

To help farmers and society it was decided with the help of local police (Deccan Gymkhana Police station, Pune) to arrange the vegetables and fruits directly from farmers. Till date Four such weekly markets (Law College Cannel Road 2 times, Deccan Gymkhana Area, Patwardhan Baug) have been arranged. Keeping the social distancing in mind peoples were given token numbers and time slots. More than 2600 people took advantage of these markets.

#### **1.1 Home Delivery to Elder People**

Along with local Vegetables around 450 Elderly Families were given home delivery of fruits and vegetables. This help vulnerable population to stay home and stay safe.

## NGO streamlines veggie shopping in Deccan with tokens, time slots

Pune: To ensure minimal crowding, NGO Keshav Sita Memorial Foundation Trust has developed a special token and time slot system for purchasing vegetables in the Deccan area.

The residents reached Canal Road as per the allotted time slot to purchase vegetables and fruits on Wednesday. As many as 440 residents living around Abhinav Marathi Medium School, Law Colkge Road, Bhandarkar Road and Prabhat Road booked tokens between Sunday evening and Tuesday evening before stepping out to purchase vegetablesas pertheir allotment.

Trustee of the NGO Shirish Phadiare said, "For the last five years, our trust has been working on plastic collection in these areas and we are in touchwith several residents over WhatsApp. They told us

that they were facing difficulty in finding fresh fruits and wegetables. We apole to additional commissioner of police Sanjay Shinde to seek the required permission. On approval, we tied up with an agency called Shashwat to set up the stall. We have received comple-

te support from the Deccan Gymkhana police station." Another trustee Medha Tadpatrikar said, "On reaching Canal Raad, the residents were required to hand over a list of requirement to a staff member seated at a desk. Meanwhile, other staffers

started packing the listed items. Payment was made at the last counter. We are planning to organize this activity twice a week until the lockdown ends."

Home deliveries on the basis of the token system have also been started since Tuesday.


